CHARACTERISTICS

This mixture captivates with its diversity. The result varies depending on the sowing period. When sown in spring, the annuals dominate the outcome. Autumn sowing places the emphasis on biennials and perennial plants.

Plant height: 50-100 cm

Flowering:

From summer onwards for spring sowings

From spring onwards in subsequent years

Composed of 28 annuals and 24 perennials.
