

Inter-row compact mixture

MP08729 - Ecosystems - Biodiversity

CHARACTERISTICS

This perennial mixture of dwarf species is a beneficial blend designed to be sown in strips between or around fruit orchards. The flowering vegetation provides shelter for beneficial insects such as pollinators and predators. This mixture produces a low-growing vegetation so as not to interfere with harvesting and orchard maintenance.

Plant height: 20-40 cm

Flowering:

From summer when sown in spring

From spring in subsequent years

Composed of 6 annual and 11 perennial species.
