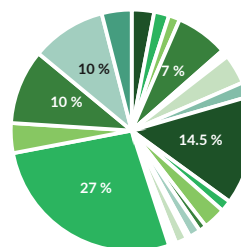


2-year flower mixture

COMPOSITION

Fodder radish	3%	Oxeye daisy	1%
Wild carrot	2%	Common poppy	1.5%
Cornflower	1.5%	Yarrow	0.5%
Camelina	7%	Chicory	1.5%
Wild teasel	0.5%	Common vetch	0.5%
Bird's-foot trefoil	0.5%	Red clover	0.5%
Buckwheat	4%	Triticale	27%
Brown knapweed	2%	Fodder kale	4%
Spring oats	14.5%	Rye	10%
Black medick	1.5%	Sunflower	10%
Fennel	3%	Lucerne	4%



CHARACTERISTICS

- 2-year flower mixture for the management agreement "flower field".
- A flower field increases the food supply (pollen & nectar) for insects (bees & butterflies).
- This improves their survival chances. More insects also means more food for all field birds.
- SOWING INFO
- Sow in late summer before the start of the management agreement or at the latest before May 1st of the 1st year.
- From the 2nd year onwards, resow 1/2 of the area each year.
- Alternate reseeded areas annually.

USE

- In accordance with management agreement "flower field".

SOWING INFO

7 kg/ha
