

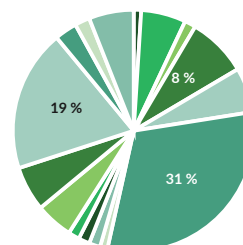
Perennial mixture for functional agrobiodiversity (F.A.B.)

DESCRIPTION

- Perennial mixture mainly composed of herbs and legumes formulated within the framework of the "flower field" management agreement.

COMPOSITION

Yarrow	1%	Common poppy	1.5%
Dill	6%	Cornflower	1.5%
Oxeye daisy	1.5%	Corn marigold	5%
Parsnip	8%	Bird's-foot trefoil	6%
Hairy vetch	6%	Red clover	19%
Common vetch	31%	Borage	3%
Wild teasel	1%	Fennel	2%
Wild carrot	1.5%	Pot marigold	6%



CHARACTERISTICS

- Perennial mixture mainly composed of herbs and legumes formulated within the framework of the "flower field" management agreement.
- SOWING INFO
- Sow in late summer before the start of the management agreement or at the latest before May 1st of the 1st year.
- Resow in late summer of the 2nd or 3rd working year.
- Each year: Mow the entire area between September 15th and October 31st and always remove the cut material.

USE

- In accordance with the "flower field" management agreement.
- In accordance with eco-scheme (CAP) subsidy "buffer strip plus - flower mixture".
- (code VA 9831- BUB)
- In accordance with eco-scheme (CAP) subsidy "flower strip in fruit growing".
- (code VA 9831- BFB or BFR)

- In case of "BFR" Flower strip at the edge of the orchard, seeding rate min. 20 kg/ha
